To take part in the competition you need to identify an area of your school which you could 'Rewild'. This could mean you develop an area to attract insects, build bug hotels have or develop a wildflower garden, or create an inspiring wild space. The possibilities are endless!

How to take part

- 1. Take a photo or video of what the area at your school looks like prior to the development.**
- 2. Working with a class or group of children come up with a plan for how you will develop the site.**
- 3. During the summer term develop the site area**
- 4. Take a video or photo at the end of the summer term or early autumn term to evidence the change that has been made to your site.**

Prizes

Prizes will be awarded to all schools based on the following Criteria;

- Innovative design**
- Involvement of the children in the project**
- Impact on the area for wild life**

First Prize – A visit to the Cabilla Rainforest – Bodmin for a class of Children

Second Prize - A visit to 'Rewilding' Coombeshead for a class of children

Third Prize – A Senior Wild Tribe Ranger visit
